# From Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

In 1996, then Joseph Cardinal Ratzinger published a book called *A New Song for the Lord: Faith in Christ and Liturgy Today*. It was my freshman year of college and it was one of those books that profoundly shaped my reflection on liturgy and music. In it, he wrote:

*Today we are generally no longer capable of seeing that the matter of God is something most real, indeed, the true key to our deepest human needs. This, however, shows how serious the sickness of our civilization is. Indeed, there will be no cure if God is not recognized as the structural core of our whole existence. Only in togetherness of God, being with God, does human life become real life. Without him it remains below its threshold and destroys itself. Redemptive togetherness or union with God, however, is possible only in the one whom he sent and through whom he himself is a God with us. We cannot construct this togetherness. Christ is the life because he leads us into this union with God. It is only from there that the wellspring of living water comes.*

The sickness of our civilization is rooted in the forgetfulness of God. And even within the Church, our worship has been flattened, horizontalized, and secularized to such an extent that the most appalling abuses can go on and on and few Catholics even recognize how far the celebration of the Paschal Mystery is divorced from the sacred reality behind it. Ratzinger's last work was a provocative book with a deceptively simple title, *What is Christianity?* In it he makes a claim that should make us pause:

*The doings of men almost made us forget the presence of God. In such a situation, it became increasingly clear that the existence of the church is vitally dependent on the correct celebration of the liturgy and that the church is in danger when the primacy of God no longer appears in the liturgy and thus in life. The most profound reason for the crisis that upset the church lies in the eclipse of God's priority in the liturgy.*

Remember when we come to Mass:

## IT IS NOT ABOUT YOU!

## MASS IS THE WORSHIP JESUS RENDERS TO THE FATHER IN THE SPIRIT, THE FRUITS OF WHICH WE RECEIVE IN HOLY COMMUNION.

When you are tempted to look at your watch, and get distracted, or complain about the homily or the music or the behavior of those around you, remember this. You are here for the glory of God, and for no other reason. Remember this when you engage in full, active and conscious participation, both interiorly with the heart and exteriorly with your body (especially your voice, the only instrument created by God). Also, it is vitally important to form your children from their earliest moments to respect the sacred and be reverent in church. (And if you have teenagers, this whole getting up and down to go to the bathroom a million times during Mass because they are "bored" needs to be addressed by firm but gentle parenting.). It is also important for our elders to remember that silence is important to preserve the church as a place of prayer and contemplation. Be the example of joyful meditation and loving charity.

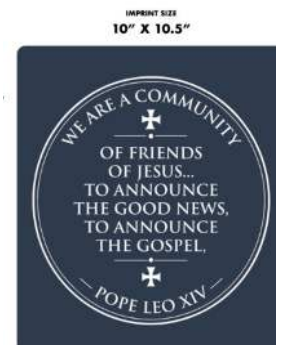


