Summer Guest Author Series 4

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

During Lent, we invited parishioners to participate in our *Lenten Testimony Challenge* by prayerfully reflecting on how God has worked in their lives and writing a testimony following a simple outline: **Before** – What was my life like? What was missing? **Encounter** – How did Jesus get my attention? **After** – How has my life or relationship with God changed? We have continued to receive beautiful testimonies of God's quiet and faithful work, and throughout our *Summer Guest Author Series* we are honored to share some of them—anonymously when requested—to encourage others in their own walk with Christ. I grew up in a faithful Catholic family in Narragansett, RI. I attended Mass every Sunday, went to Catholic school, and checked all the boxes of a good cradle Catholic. I believed in God, but if I'm honest, I trusted myself more than Him. My formula for life was simple: work hard, stay disciplined, and good things would happen. That mindset resulted in academic and athletic success through High School and College, and ultimately into the Marine Corps as a Commissioned Officer, where perseverance and self-reliance were also rewarded. Looking back, I realize I had spent years inviting God into my plans instead of asking Him to lead my life.

Then, for the first time, my formula failed.

After an assignment fell through and a relationship fell apart, I found myself alone, questioning the direction of my life. No amount of hard work could fix what had happened. I struggled with loneliness and turned to unhealthy ways of coping that only left me feeling emptier. I still attended Mass, but I was mostly going through the motions. For the first time, I had exhausted my own answers.

One Sunday after Mass, I wandered into a bookstore and found a small book on a clearance table titled *Queen of Angels: Mary's Answers to Universal Questions*. Through the Blessed Mother's words, I felt an invitation to stop trying to control my life and place my trust completely in her Son, Jesus. That evening, I prayed with a sincerity and boldness I had never experienced before and asked God for a sign that He was truly leading me.

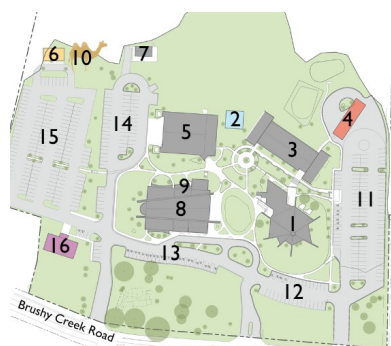
The very next morning, I was unexpectedly offered the opportunity to deploy with the 22nd Marine Expeditionary Unit. What seemed like another military assignment became the beginning of a new chapter in my faith. During that deployment, I was blessed to visit many of the places where Jesus walked, including Jerusalem and the Sea of Galilee. When I returned, military orders brought me to the Pentagon, where I met my future wife, Lisa. Looking back now, I can clearly see that what I once thought were coincidences were moments of God's providence.

Years later, while living in Baton Rouge, I attended my first ACTS retreat. It was there that everything God had been teaching me over the previous years finally came together. I realized that Jesus wasn't asking me simply to believe in Him—He was asking me to surrender to Him. That surrender has certainly had its ups and downs, but it continues to shape me every day as a husband, father, and disciple of Christ. God's providence eventually brought our family to Greenville and to Prince of Peace Catholic Church, where we have found not only a parish, but a true spiritual home.

My testimony is simple: when I finally stopped relying on myself and began trusting Jesus, through the loving guidance of our Blessed Mother, I discovered that God's plans for my life were far greater than anything I could have imagined for myself.

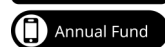

Living a truly Catholic life is the greatest adventure and the most fulfilling vocation any of us can embrace, regardless of the state in life to which God has called us. We are called to know, love, and serve God in this life, but amid the noise and competing claims of our modern world, it can be challenging to understand clearly both what the Church teaches and why it matters.

Young adults (ages 18–30)—whether working, recently graduated from high school, or beginning college—are invited to join a weekly study rooted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
